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Emergency Access Program



The purpose of this system is to provide access to residences in response to emergency calls from or on behalf of senior and/or disabled residents.

The Emergency Access Program allows residents who have installed a garage door keypad, or a lock box containing a front door key, to provide the access code to Casa Grande Police Department volunteers. The record of that code, with the resident's permission to use it, is maintained only by the Police Department, while the code is entered into a database for access by the 911 Dispatch system. This information is only available in the event of an emergency.

Residents who lack the resources to provide their own access control may request a lock box unit provided, free of charge, by the Police Department. These lock boxes are installed and serviced by CGPD volunteers. As noted above, the codes for these boxes are only available to First Responders when emergency access is required.
