Care for your clients with patience and find ways to support them emotionally, intellectually, and physically. Steer away from controversial topics and learn about their personalities. Begin your shift with a smile and make it your priority to give the best care you can to your client. Stop and think through your next actions if you are presented with a difficult situation. If you cannot find a solution that works for you, seek out support and guidance from your case manager and the office staff."

Nadya has thoroughly enjoyed working with her client's case manager Elizabeth Quagraine. She said, "Elizabeth is wonderful and lovely! She works hard to understand me as a person. I trust her. She makes me feel safe about sharing my needs and challenges, and if I feel uncomfortable, she will help me – she is always there for me."

"Nadya comes to our rescue with call-outs whenever she can," Julie said.
