"My advice to other caregivers would be to connect with your client on a personal level," Sam said. "Give them space when needed, and read the changes in their behavior to plan how you proceed. Remember that you are doing something good for another person, helping them to be comfortable in their later years."

When Sam arrived in the United States, his first wife was already here, working as a home care provider. She recommended the field to Sam, and he soon earned his Home Health Aide (HHA) certification. He worked for various agencies before joining Visiting Angels Newton/Canton, after being referred to us by a friend.

Sam has enjoyed being a member of our team throughout the years. He values the educational opportunities and support he has received from the staff and case managers. Sam is incredibly grateful to work with RN Case Manager Katherine Jennings on his present case.
