
Devotion to family and respect for tradition, including the deeply held belief that family members support and care for each other as the years go by, have long been defining characteristics of those who call our community home.

Members of the "Sandwich Generation," people born between 1946 and 1964 are being squeezed between the need to care for growing children and their aging parents.


