
## THE OLD FARMER'S ALMANAC

Parkinson's disease is a brain disorder that leads to shaking, stiffness, and difficulty with walking, balance, and coordination. Parkinson's symptoms usually begin gradually and get worse over time. Medication and therapies can help with the side effects of the disease. There is no known cure for Parkinson's Disease. See your doctor regularly to keep them informed of any changes in your health.

Music Therapy for Alzheimer's patients. Singing **songs** can provide emotional and behavioral benefits for people with **Alzheimer's disease** and other types of **dementia**. Musical memories are often preserved in **Alzheimer's disease** because key brain areas linked to musical memory are relatively undamaged by the **disease**.

crescent rolls 8 hot dogs 1 egg, lightly beaten <u>Directions</u>

Preheat oven to 375\*. Separate crescent dough into triangles. Place hot dogs at wide ends of triangles and roll up. Place on ungreased baking sheet. Combine egg and water, brush over rolls. Sprinkle with Caraway over tops press lightly Bake 12-15 minutes or until golden brown.
