

Sloppy Joes

1 pound of lean ground beef

¼ cup chopped onion

¼ cup chopped green bell pepper

½ teaspoon garlic powder

1 teaspoon prepared yellow mustard

¾ cup ketchup

3 teaspoons brown sugar salt to taste pepper to taste



In a medium skillet over medium heat, brown the ground beef, onion and green pepper; drain off liquids.

Stir in the garlic powder, mustard, ketchup and brown sugar; mix thoroughly. Reduce heat, and simmer for 30 minutes. Season with Salt and Pepper.
