Ingredients

- 1 box vanilla cake mix
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- 2 large eggs
- ½ c. canola oil
- ½ c. red and green sprinkles

Cake Mix Cookies



1. Preheat oven to 350* and line two baking sheets with parchment. In a large bowl, whisk together cake mix and baking powder; in another bowl, whisk together eggs and oil. Add wet ingredients to dry and stir until fully combined
2. Add sprinkles and stir until mixed (the more you stir, the more colors will stain the dough)
3. Using your hands, form small balls of dough and transfer to baking sheets
4. Bake 7-9 minutes. Let cool slightly on baking sheet, then transfer to wire rack to cool.

RED FLAGS



Any phone call asking for money, Unusual credit card charges (what is being charged on cards), bank withdrawals (unusual bank activity), Credit reports (has anyone opened accounts in their name), Grandparent scam (grandchild needs money and asks to wire money), IRS scam (says they owe money).
