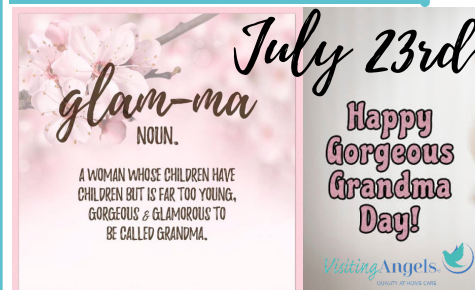
Gather as much family history as you can at these functions. Take the time to listen to their stories and pass those stories on to the next generation. Time passes too quickly.
