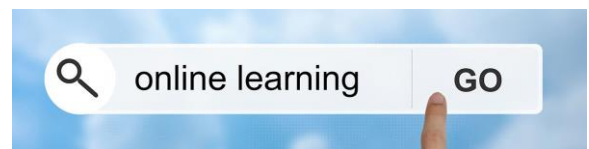

10 Amazing Facts for the 4th of July

- * Benjamin Franklin wanted the Turkey to be the National Bird, but he was out-voted
- * The stars on the original flag were arranged in a circle to ensure all colonies were represented
- * John Hancock was the only person to actually sign the Declaration of Independence on July 4th, 1776. The other 55 signers did not sign until later.
- * Thomas Jefferson and John Adams died on the same day: July 4th, 1826, the fiftieth anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence.
- * History's first submarine attack took place in New York Harbor in 1776. There were NO fireworks on July 4th, 1776. This was still 6 years before Americans knew whether the new nation would survive the war.
- * George Washington was the best spymaster in American History! He ran espionage rings in British-held areas and he was a genius in mis-information. He led them to believe his inflated reports of the strength of his army.
- * Washington was robust and seemed to have an immunity to disease and bullets. In one encounter he absorbed 4 bullets in his coat and hat and had 2 horses shot from under him.
